A MESSAGE FROM ACADEMIC ADVISOR

We are pleased to present to you the March 2019 issue of our Newsletter. The interest expressed by our readers and the feedback provided by them keeps us motivated to continue its publication. It has now emerged as a useful comparator for our colleges, faculty and students regarding their activities and achievements. The intervening examinations, vacations and elections have all contributed to the delay in bringing out this issue. We apologise for the same.

There have been significant developments during this period. The Ramanbhai Patel Post Graduate Centre was inaugurated at the L M College of Pharmacy. This Centre was established by Shri Pankajbhai Patel, CMD of Zydus Cadilla, in the memory of his father Shri Ramanbhai Patel with a handsome donation of Rupees 8.3 Crores. This Centre will offer the Pharm D Program and also house the Atal Incubation Centre. Both Shri Ramanbhai Patel and Shri Pankaj Patel are Alumni of LMCP. The auditorium was renovated and upgraded at the M G Science Institute with a donation of Rupees 50 Lakhs from Shri Shankarbhai Patel, a distinguished Alumnus of the Institute. Infrastructure repair and renovation is also being carried out by AES at all the colleges in a phased manner.

Several noteworthy conferences and seminars were organised by the colleges, which had registration and participation from many parts of the country and state. A G Teachers College organised an ICSSR sponsored National Conference on "Learning beyond the Classroom". LMCP hosted the GTU Central Tech-Fest which had 1600 pharmacy students from all over the state participate. The AES organised a one day seminar on Outcome based Education: Achieving Excellence through Learning Outcomes, in which in a very first, over 100 faculty members from all the colleges participated. The seminar was facilitated by M G Science Institute.

Our students continue to secure top ranks in university examinations and also emerge as winners in several cultural and sports events, at the university and state level. Some faculty are engaged in high quality research and are publishing their work in reputed international journals. This is one area in which we have to do much more in the years ahead.

The Management continues its efforts to improve the quality of our programmes, in spite of several challenges faced on account of the university limitations as well as government rules and regulations. To overcome these problems, we propose to strengthen our efforts to seek autonomy as per the guidelines provided by the UGC and the State Government.

Inauguration of Ramanbhai Patel Post Graduate Center

Ramanbhai Patel Post Graduate Center has been established at L. M. College of Pharmacy (LMCP), in memory of late Shri Ramanbhai Patel, an eminent industrialist of India, by his son Shri Pankajbhai Patel (CMD, Zydus-Cadila). Late Shri Ramanbhai Patel and Shri Pankajbhai Patel are both distinguished alumni of LMCP. The Post Graduate center was inaugurated on 18th October, 2018 in the august presence of Shri Pankajbhai Patel, CMD, Zydus-Cadila; Shri Sanjaybhai Lalbhai, President, Ahmedabad Education Society (AES)



and Shri Sudhirbhai Mehta, CMD, Torrent Group. Dignitaries from pharmaceutical industry and faculty from reputed institutions of the state were also present at the ceremony. This center shall offer the Pharm. D. Course, which has been duly approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi and All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi. It will also house the Atal Incubation Center (AIC), the first pharma and healthcare center supported by NITI Aayog, New Delhi.

Upgradation of LMCP laboratory

Zydus-Hospira Oncology Pvt. Ltd, Ahmedabad has agreed to donate instruments worth Fifty lakh rupees to LMCP towards purchase of certain laboratory equipment. The donor is a leading pharmaceutical company and as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), promotes education through various initiatives. Under this initiative the donor will provide sophisticated instruments like Gas Chromatograph, Biosafety Cabinet Level II, Refrigerated centrifuge, dissolution apparatus ½ immersion cell, UV/Visible Spectrophotometer etc. to LMCP. 








Alumni activities:
